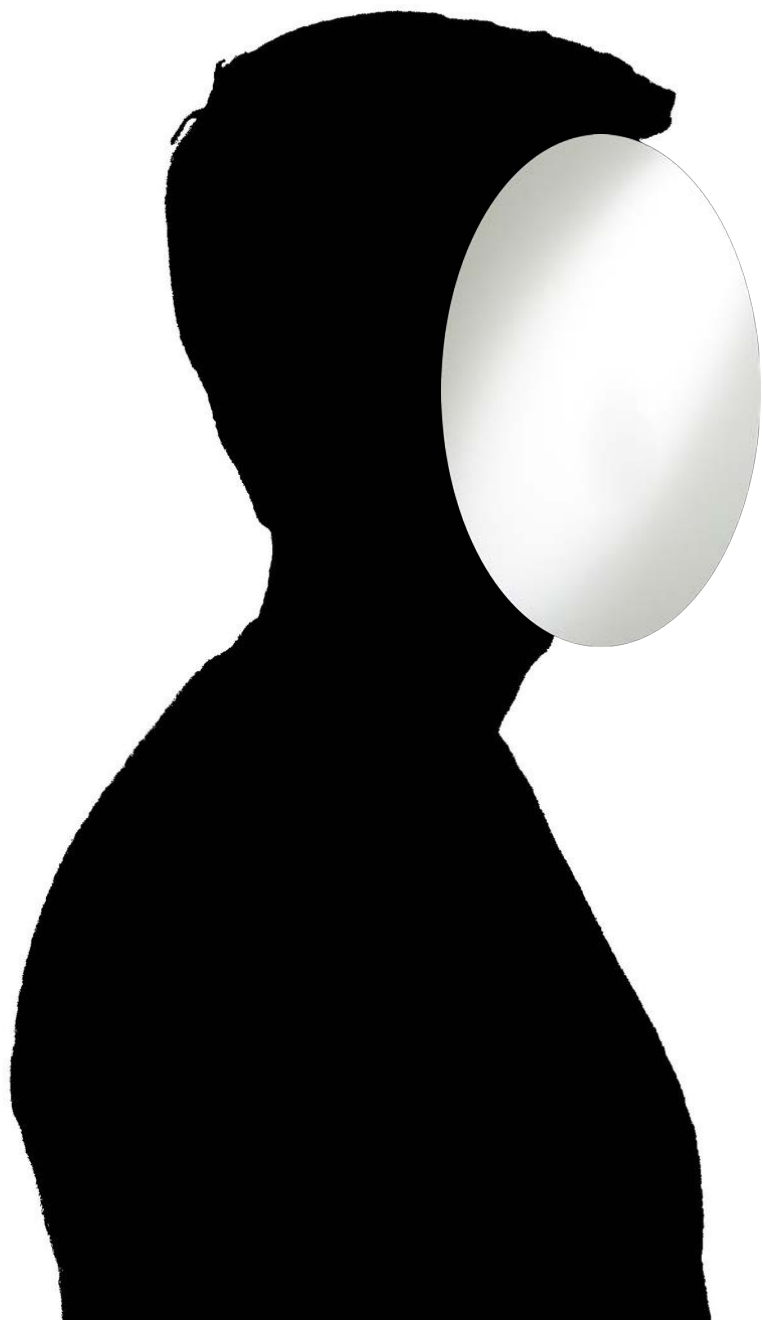
You have searched me, LORD, and you know me.

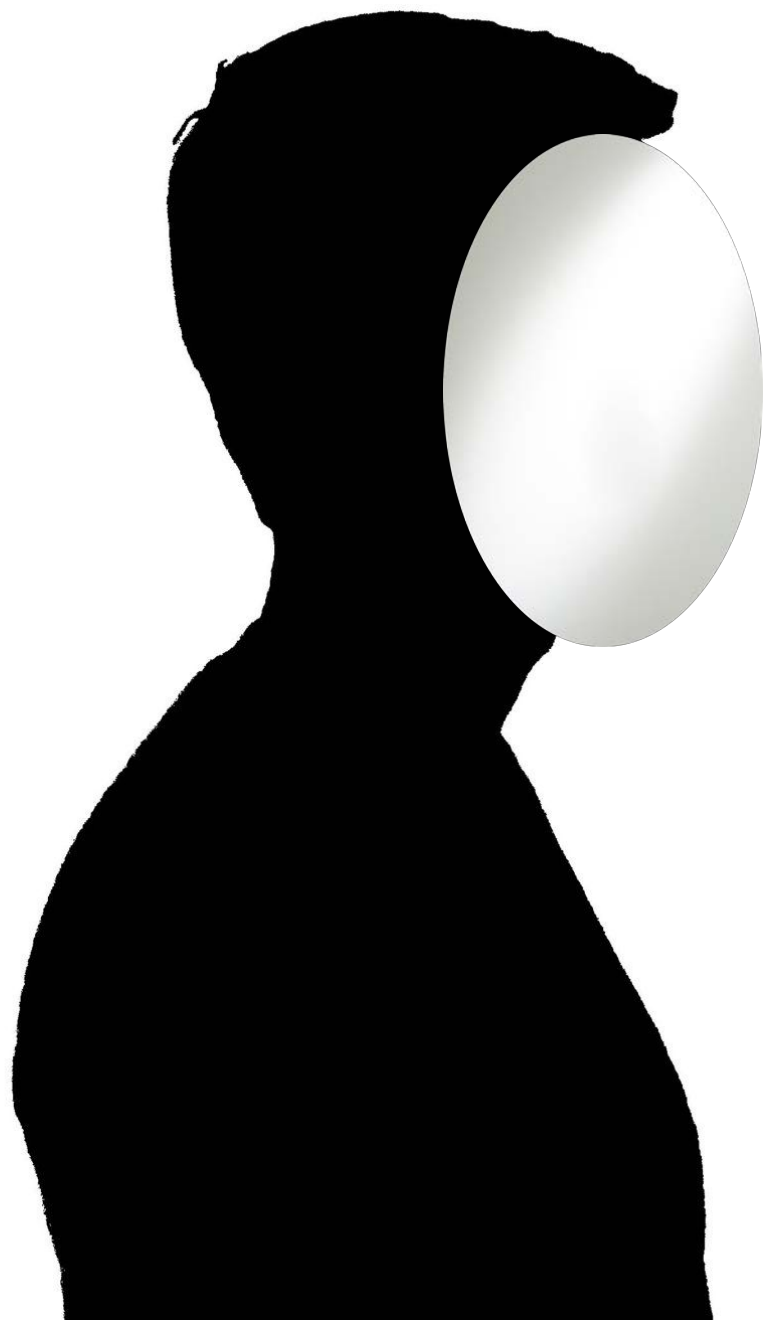




PSALM 139:2-4 (NIV)

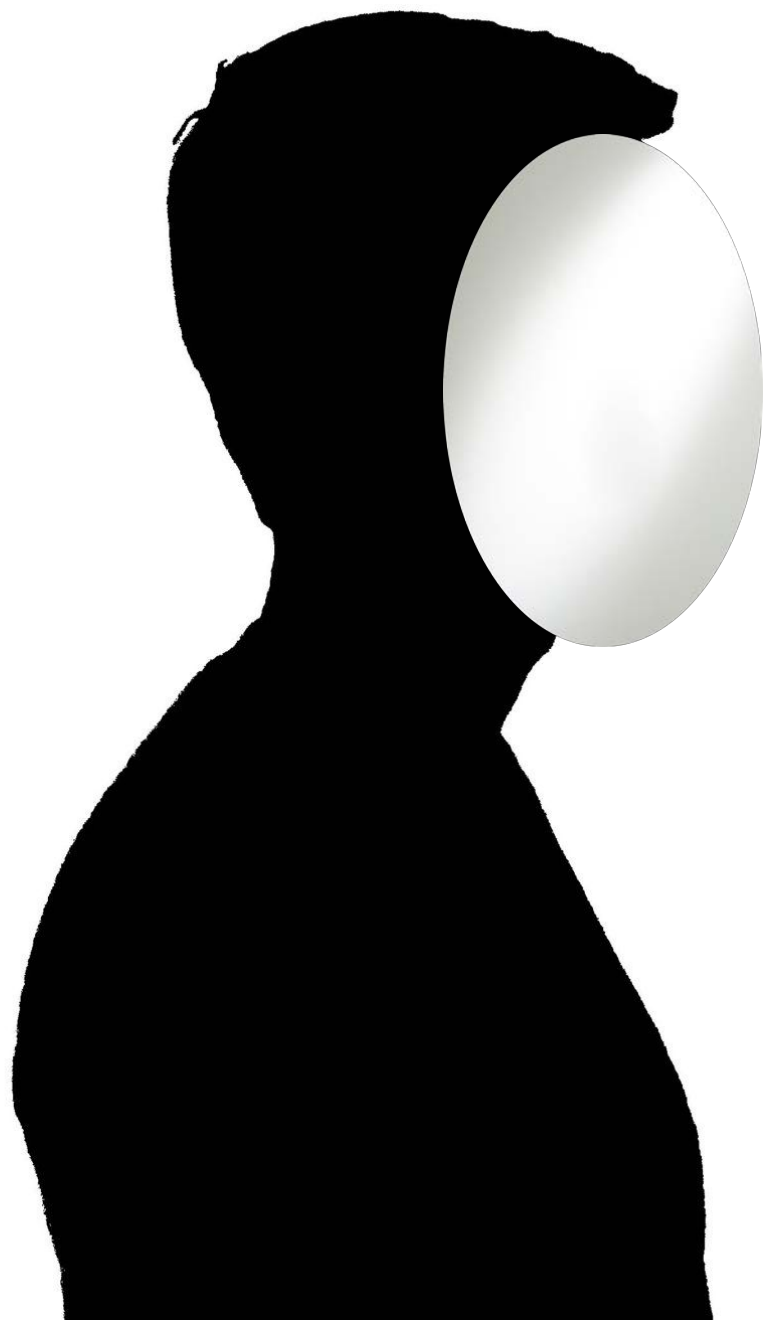

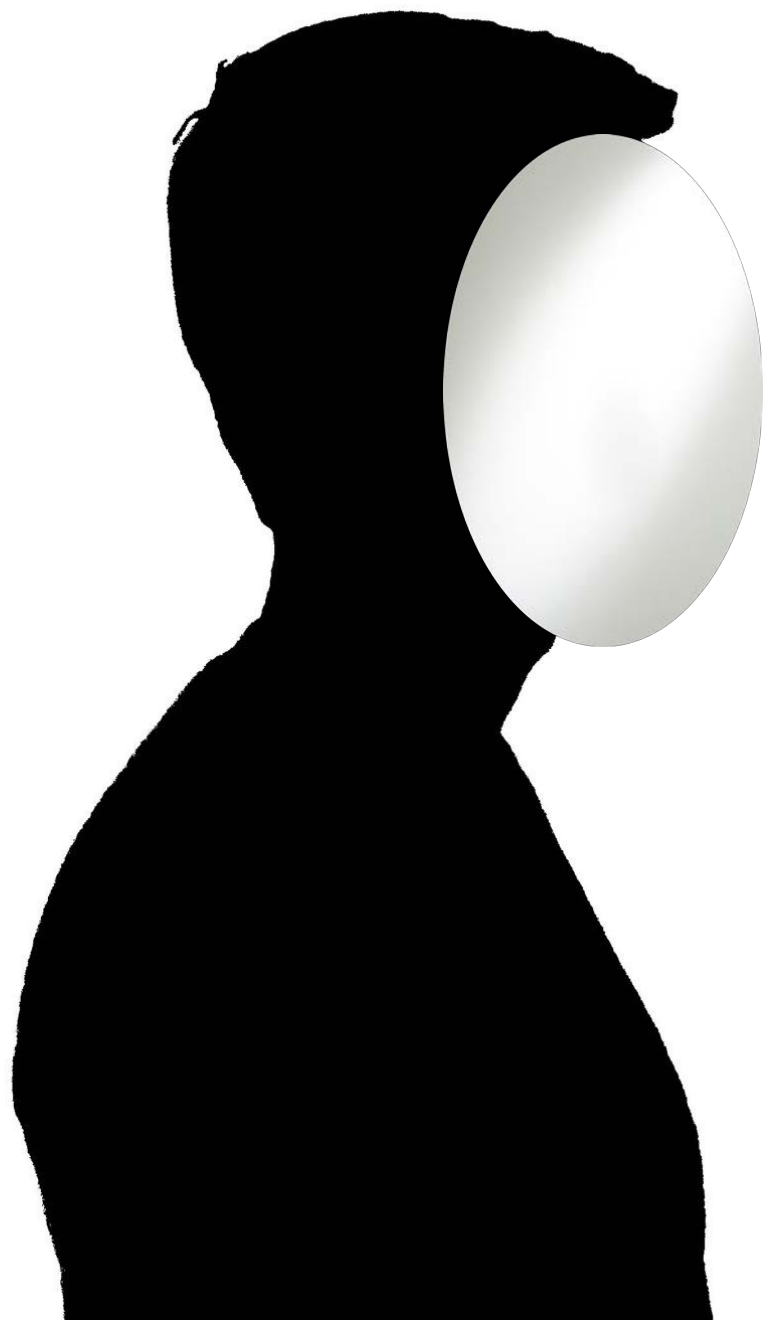
