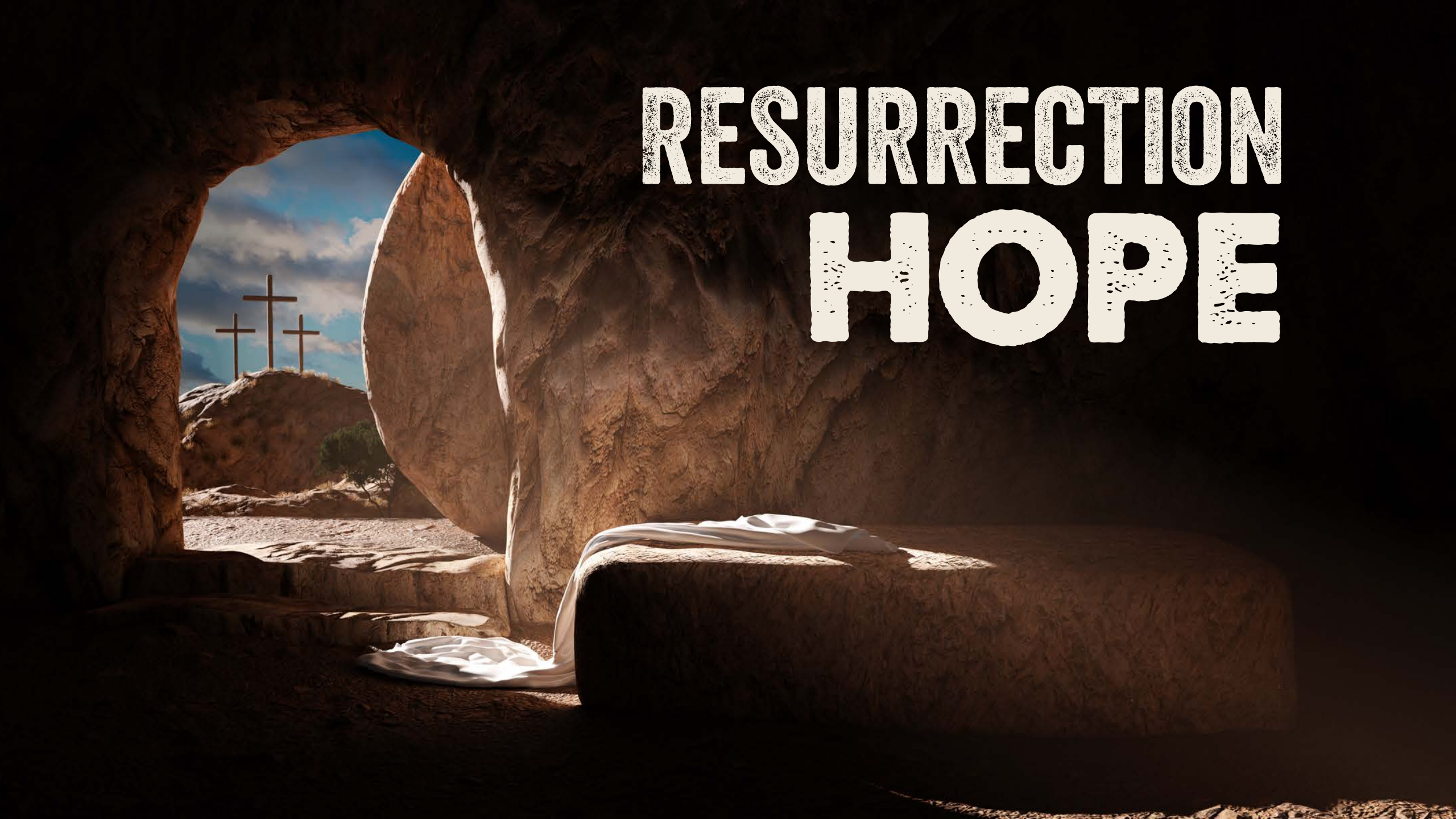


RESURRECTION HOPE



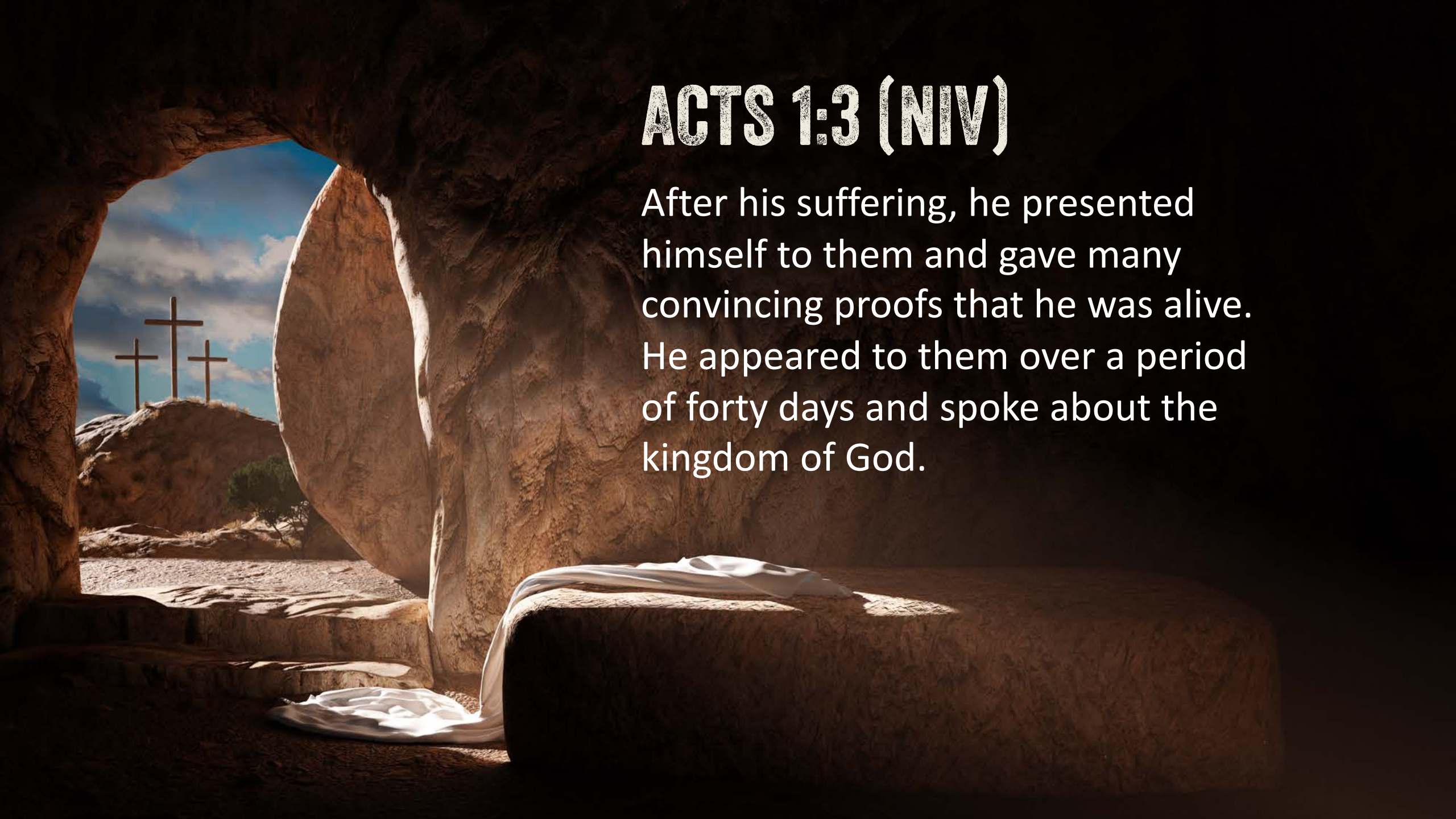
An empty tomb with a large stone rolled away and a white cloth on the floor, with crosses visible in the background.

After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God.



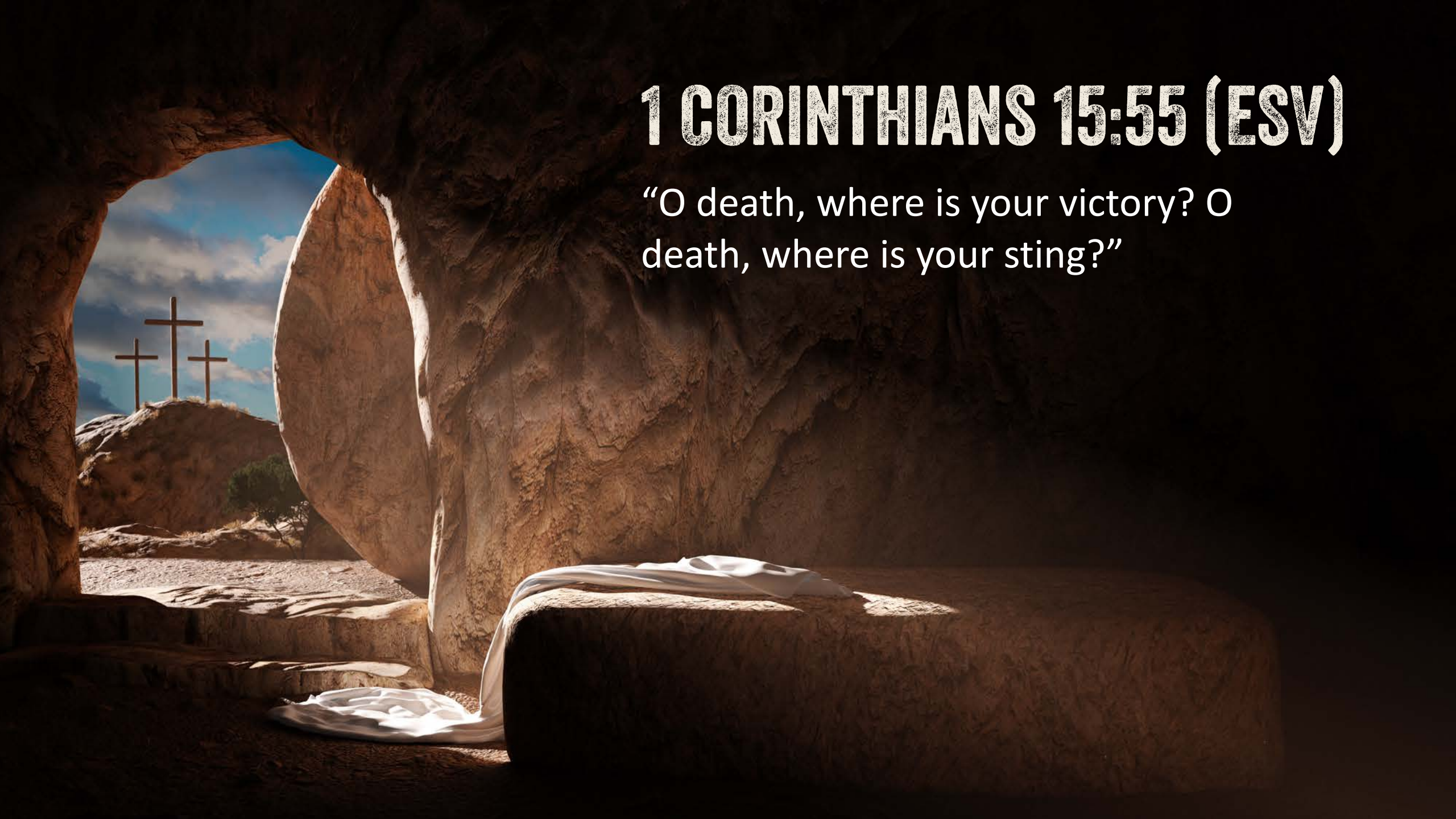


ECCLESIASTES 3:11 (NIV)

“O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?”



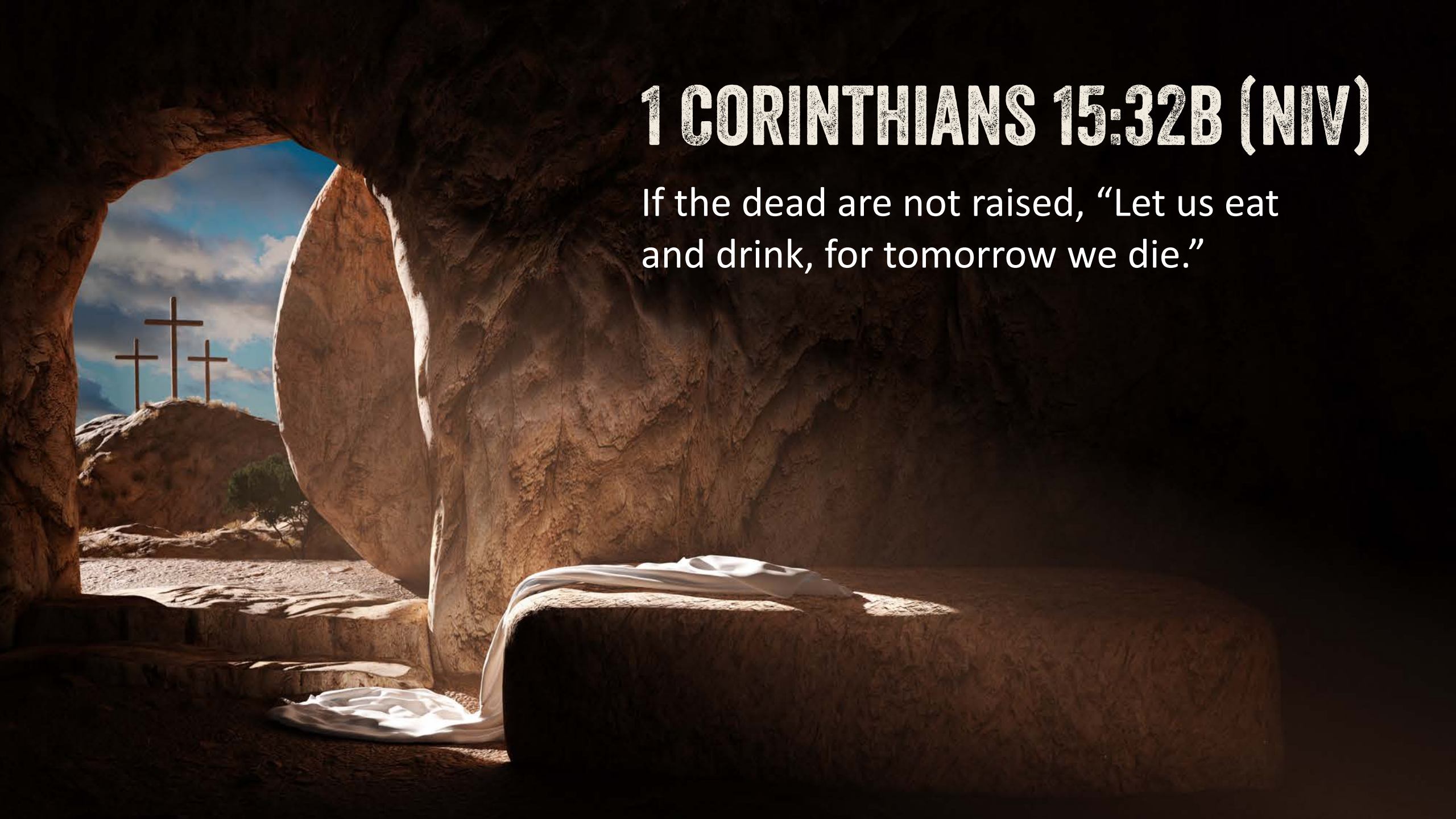


ROMANS 8:11 (NLT)
