A fellowship of Christ's suffering: "I want to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised Him from the dead. I want to suffer with Him, sharing in His death."

A fellowship of support: "Even so, you have done well to share with me in my present difficulty. As you know, you Philippians were the only ones who gave me financial help when I first brought you the Good News and then traveled on from Macedonia. No other church did this."
