## Mark 1:16-18

<sup>16</sup> One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and his brother Andrew throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living. <sup>17</sup> Jesus called out to them, “Come, **follow Me (imitate Me; apprentice with Me)**, and I will show you how to fish for people!” <sup>18</sup> And they left their nets at once and followed Him.

**Mark 3:14** “He appointed twelve that they might be with Him ...”

**John 15:5** “Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain (live/abide) in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.”

# Matthew 7:24-27

<sup>24</sup> “Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. <sup>25</sup> Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won’t collapse because it is built on bedrock. <sup>26</sup> But anyone who hears my teaching and doesn’t obey it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. <sup>27</sup> When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash.”
