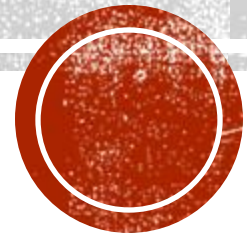


# HEALTHY CHURCH

## **ACTS 2:42**

“All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord’s Supper), and to prayer.”



# REVELATION 2:4 AND 20

“I know your deeds ... but you have lost your first love.”

“I know your deeds ... but I have this complaint against you. You are permitting that woman—that Jezebel who calls herself a prophet—to lead my servants astray. She teaches them to commit sexual sin and to eat food offered to idols.”



# REVELATION 3:1 AND 15

“I know your deeds ... you have a reputation for being alive—but you are dead.”

“I know your deeds ... but you are lukewarm.”



# **ACTS 1:3**

# **ACTS 4:13**
