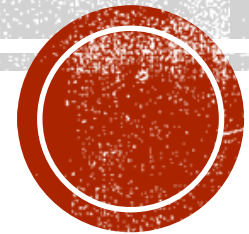


GOD, IS THAT REALLY YOU?

EXODUS 34:6-7A

“⁶ The LORD (I AM) passed in front of Moses, calling out, ‘Yahweh! The LORD! The God of compassion and mercy! I am slow to anger and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness. ⁷ I lavish unfailing love to a thousand generations. I forgive iniquity, rebellion, and sin.’”
