





An Expression of WORTH


LUKE 12:34 (NIV)

[6] Then Moses gave an order and they sent this word throughout the camp: “No man or woman is to make anything else as an offering for the sanctuary.”


And so the people were **restrained from bringing more**, [7] because what they already had was more than enough to do all the work.

But the king replied to Araunah, “No, I insist on paying you for it. I will not sacrifice to the LORD my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing.”





MARK 9:31-32 (NIV)


[31] He said to them, “The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise.” [32]

But **they did not understand what he meant** and were afraid to ask him about it.




JOHN 12:3 (NIV)

JOHN 12:4-6 (NLT)



MARK 12:41-42 (NIV)

[41] Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. [42] But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents.



MARK 12:43-44 (NIV)

[43] Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, “Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others.

[44] They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—**all she had to live on.**”




1 TIMOTHY 6:17 (NIV)
