[2] After three days the officers went throughout the camp, [3] giving orders to the people: “When you see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the Levitical priests carrying it, you are to move out from your positions and follow it.

[4] Then you will know which way to go, **since you have never been this way before.**

# PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7 (NLT)

[6] Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. [7] Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.



# PSALM 143:8,10 (NLT)

[8] Let me hear of your unfailing love each morning, for I am trusting you. **Show me where to walk**, for I give myself to you. ... [10] Teach me to do your will, for you are my God. May your gracious **Spirit lead me** forward on a firm footing.

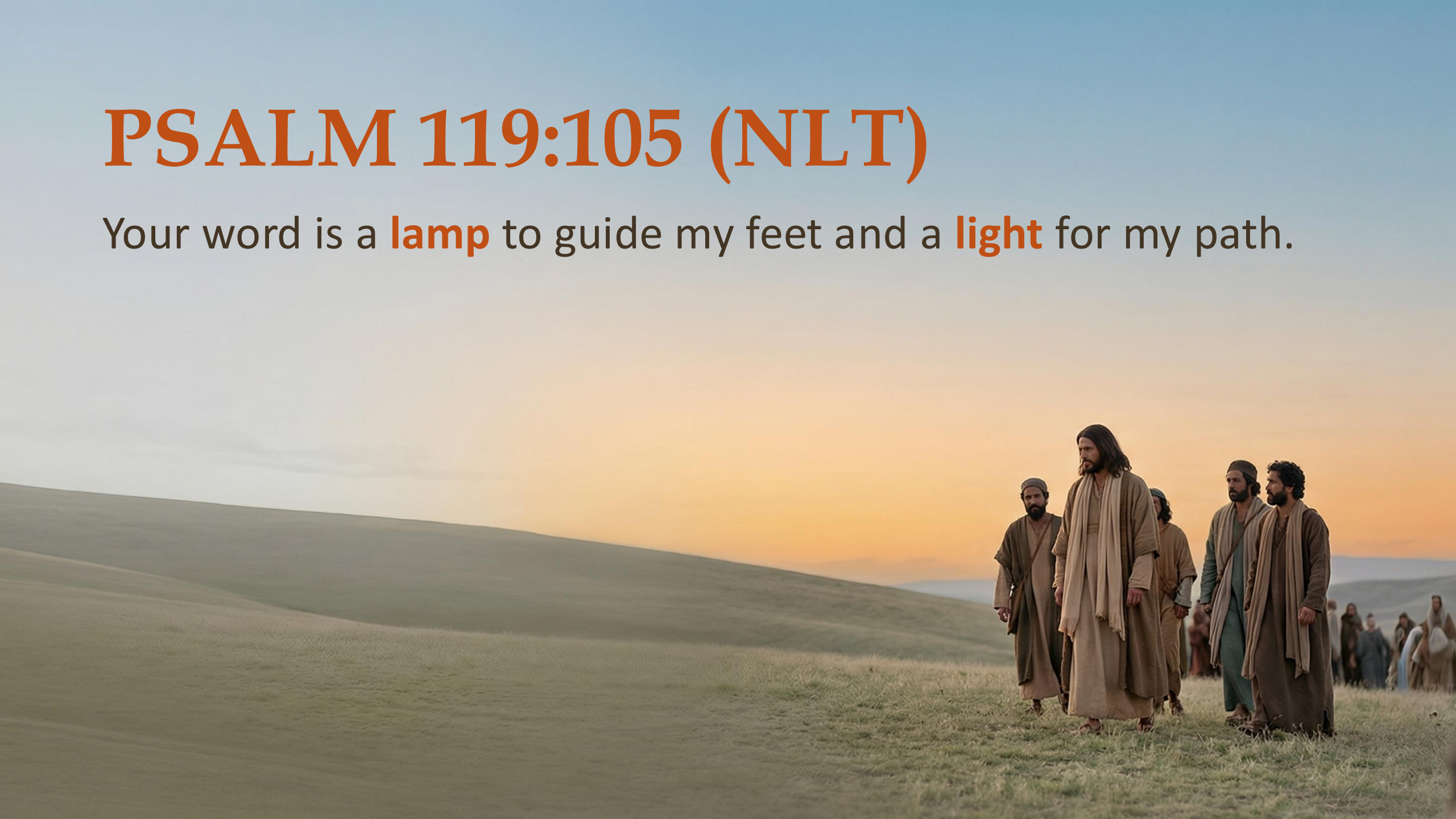


# KNOWING WHAT GOD SAYS (SCRIPTURE)

# PROVERBS 3:5-6 (NIV)

[5] **Trust** in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;  
[6] in all your ways **submit** to him, and he will make your paths straight.



# MOVING (ONLY) WHEN GOD SAYS



# NUMBERS 9:17-23 (NLT)

[17] Whenever the cloud lifted from over the sacred tent, the people of Israel would break camp and follow it. And wherever the cloud settled, the people of Israel would set up camp. [18] In this way, they traveled and camped at the LORD's command wherever he told them to go. Then they remained in their camp as long as the cloud stayed over the Tabernacle.



# NUMBERS 9:17-23 (NLT)

[19] If the cloud remained over the Tabernacle for a long time, the Israelites stayed and performed their duty to the LORD. [20] Sometimes the cloud would stay over the Tabernacle for only a few days, so the people would stay for only a few days, as the LORD commanded. Then at the LORD's command they would break camp and move on.



# NUMBERS 9:17-23 (NLT)

[21] Sometimes the cloud stayed only overnight and lifted the next morning. But day or night, when the cloud lifted, the people broke camp and moved on. [22] Whether the cloud stayed above the Tabernacle for two days, a month, or a year, the people of Israel stayed in camp and did not move on. But as soon as it lifted, they broke camp and moved on. [23] So they camped or traveled at the LORD's command, and they did whatever the LORD told them through Moses.
