



Good – Fruitful Hearts

Isaiah 5:1-4 NLT

[1] Now I will sing for the one I love a song about his vineyard: My beloved had a vineyard on a rich and fertile hill. [2] He plowed the land, cleared its stones, and planted it with the best vines. In the middle he built a watchtower and carved a winepress in the nearby rocks. Then he waited for a harvest of sweet grapes, but the grapes that grew were bitter. [3] Now, you people of Jerusalem and Judah, you judge between me and my vineyard. [4] What more could I have done for my vineyard that I have not already done? When I expected sweet grapes, why did my vineyard give me bitter grapes?
